You are doing a champion job arranging all this, Bronwyn and I really look forward to seeing you again next month.

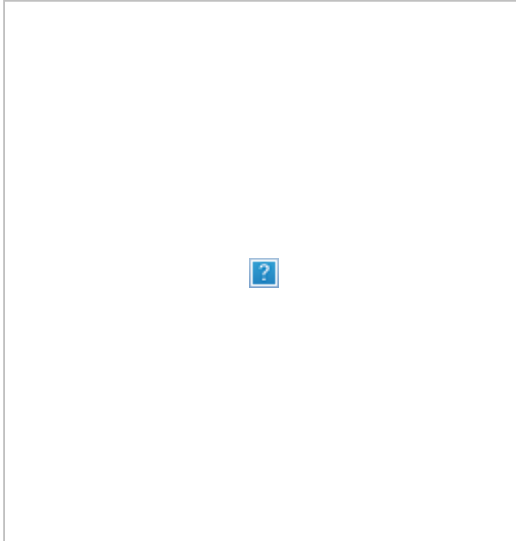

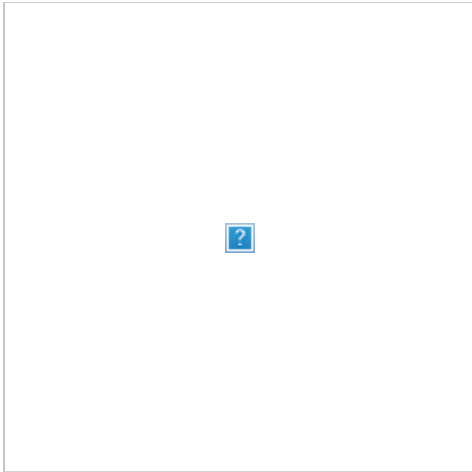

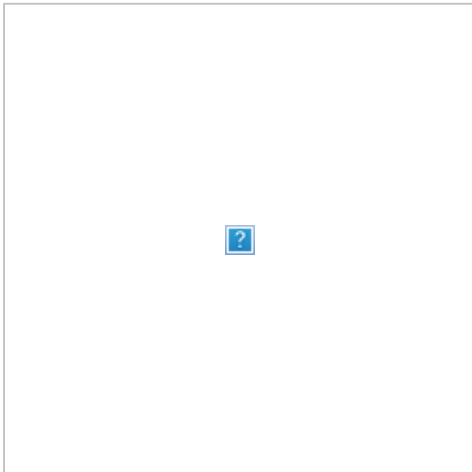
Garry and Anne on the Sydney Harbour Bridge

Jenny Bailey (nee Longmore)

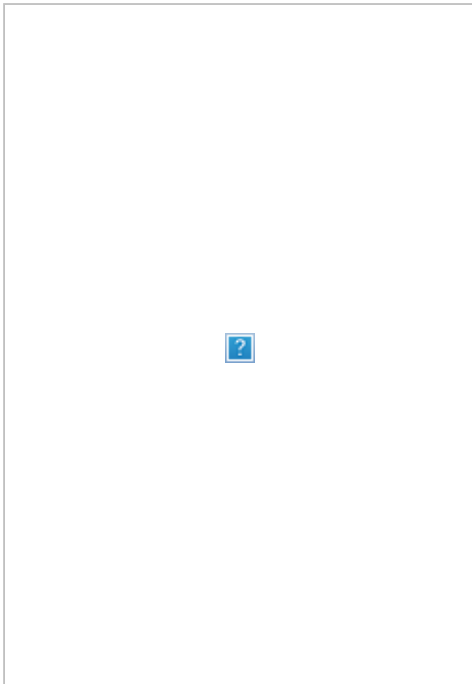
It is amazing how quickly the word is spreading. I certainly hope most people can make it to the reunion.
