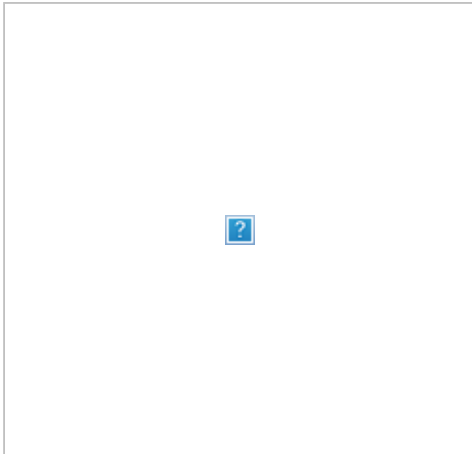
I do not have the technology to put photographs on the internet so have spared you all. I thoroughly look forward to hearing others' stories on the 12th!

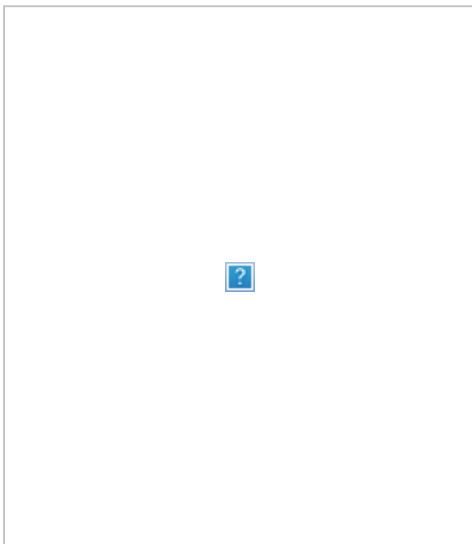
Unfortunately, cancer took Phil in 1997 and I have managed to be a single mum since then.

My career has included working with the rescue helicopter services on and off for 15 years.
